Regional Development Australia Central Coast NSW (RDACC) was created by merging the Central Coast of NSW Area Consultative Committee (CCACC) with Business Central Coast (BCC) (formerly the Economic Development Board for the Region).

Funding for the new organisation is shared between the Australian Government through the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government (DITRD LG) and the NSW State Government through Industry and Investment NSW.

RDACC commenced operation on 1 July 2009, and is located in the offices of the former BCC at the University of Newcastle, Ourimbah campus, in the Business Incubator.

Small Business Incubator

Background

The primary purpose of the Small Business Incubator is to assist start-ups and existing businesses that are currently home-based and experiencing growth on the Central Coast. It provides an intermediary step into commercial premises without the unnecessary stress of being able to meet commercial rental rates.

The Incubator is centrally located on the grounds of University of Newcastle Central Coast Campus at Ourimbah. Nestled in the natural environment, the Incubator is an ideal and strategic location for your business. Access to the F3 freeway makes it an easy journey of around 60 minutes to Sydney or Newcastle.
